

pc1is058 ~ Boxed and Faux Tube Dolls (1" dollhouse scale 1:12)



Required tools and supplies:

- X-acto knife and fresh blade
- A thin metal straight-edge ruler. Make fold lines by pressing against edge of the ruler.
- Tweezers, detailing scissors
- Good cutting mat
- Fast-grab, quick-dry white craft glue that dries clear
- An acid-free glue stick
- Small piece of aluminum foil to use as a glue pot
- Slender artist's paint brush to apply glue

Products in tutorial may look different from yours, but constructed identically to yours. You can print these tutorial pages. However, leaving the tutorial on your screen allows you to zoom in closely on the photos.



Shirley Temple Boxed Doll

1. Cut out box window first! Next cut out three pieces and fold as shown in photo.



2. Glue corner tabs. Press with tweezers. Cut acetate window and glue into place. Allow to dry.



3. Place doll insert into box and close box



The Fifth Avenue Doll

1. Follow the steps used for Shirley Temple doll for this doll.



Minnehaha Dolls

1. Follow the steps used for Shirley Temple doll for this doll.



Palmer Cox Brownies Nine-Pins

1. Follow the steps used for Shirley Temple doll (without window).



2. Cut all figures and bend stand upright.



3. Put glue on back of figures. Do not glue red stands.



4. Glue pairs together. Make sure they are flat while they dry. Splay stand.

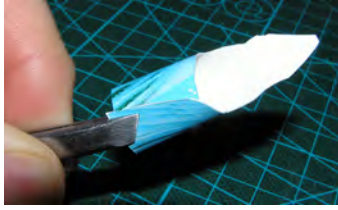


5. Stand up in order for Nine-Pins. Use a large bead for the bowling ball.



Tube International Dolls

1. Cut out figures.
2. Roll tube doll around something like a pen.



3. Glue skirts closed.



4. Bend feet upward.



Tube 1940s Girl Dolls

1. Follow the same steps for the 1940s girl dolls.
